MANDATORY FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Acknowledgement to HICAST, its authorities (Chairperson and Principal), Programme Director/ Programme Coordinator, Adviser/co-adviser, Teachers/staffs, colleagues, parents and relevant institutions providing financial, technical and other support as well as key informants and respondents in the course of study is mandatory. (1 page)

ABSTRACT

Abstract should include title of the study, location, duration of the study, and materials/methods used in the study (research tools, sampling design and sample size, etc. or experimental design, treatments, replication and statistical methods of analysis, if applicable). After this, present major findings and relevant conclusion. Conclude abstract with major suggestions (one to two). **(250-300 words)**

REFERENCING

Referencing should be done using Harvard referencing system. Visit www.hicast.edu.np for the information.

All sources cited in the text should be included in the list (references). Additional sources (not used in text) should not be included in the references.
